Club Med Buccaneer's Creek Celebrates Agreement with Delta Airlines Convenient Non-Stop Air Service from Atlanta to Fort de France

(Coral Gables, FL—December 14, 2006) This Saturday, Club Med celebrates an agreement with Delta Airlines to offer new direct flights to the French West Indies. Now, traveling to Martinique and Guadeloupe has just become hassle free. Effective December 13, Delta offers direct flights between Atlanta and Pointe a Pitre, Guadeloupe on Wednesdays and Saturdays. Beginning December 16, Delta offers direct flights between Atlanta and Fort-de-France on Saturdays. Eleven major gateways and 195 U.S. cities, including New York, Boston, Los Angeles, Chicago, San Francisco and Montreal offer connecting flights to Atlanta with minimal layover time. Delta flight passengers will arrive at the Club Med resorts on either island in time for a late lunch.

Club Med debuted its new \$60 million Club Med Buccaneer's Creek resort in Martinique, December 2005.
